

Lexington Police Department Minimum Standards

To become a Police Officer with the Lexington Police Department, you **must** meet these minimum requirements:

- 1. Must be a US citizen.
- 2. Must have High School Diploma or GED.
- 3. Must be at least 21 years of age.
- 4. Must have a valid driver's license and good driving record.
- 5. Must not ever have been convicted of an offense above the grade of a Class B Misdemeanor (Class A Misdemeanor or Felony).
- 6. Must not have been convicted of a Class B Misdemeanor within the last 10 years.
- 7. Must not have ever been placed on court-ordered community supervision for any criminal offense above the grade of a Class B Misdemeanor (Class A Misdemeanor or Felony).
- 8. Must not have been placed on court-ordered community supervision for a Class B Misdemeanor within the last 10 years from the date of the court order.
- 9. Must not have ever been convicted in any court of an offense involving family violence as defined under Chapter 71, Texas Family Code.
- 10. Must be able to successfully pass a drug test.
- 11. Must not be prohibited by State or Federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition.
- 12. Must not have ever received a dishonorable or other discharge based on misconduct which bars future military service.
- 13. Must be able to successfully pass a psychological evaluation (To be in satisfactory psychological and emotional health to perform the duties, accept the responsibilities and meet the qualifications of a patrol officer.), physical examination (To be physically sound and free from any defect which may adversely affect the performance of duty as a patrol officer.), polygraph examination and complete background investigation to include but not limited to driving history, criminal background and credit history.
- 14. Must not ever have had a Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) license denied by final order or revoked.
- 15. If currently a licensed peace officer, your TCOLE license must not be currently suspended, or a surrender of license must not currently be in effect.
